

Challenging new projects for KANON Loading Equipment BV

KANON Loading Equipment announces they were recently awarded by Dutch contractor BAM to supply 10 marine loading arms for the new Vopak terminal 'Westpoort' in Amsterdam. The supply is scheduled to be at Q1-2011.

In general, Kanon reports a significant increase of marine loading arms sales, especially when it comes to projects with large numbers and extraordinary executions. Even with a sale of over 150 pieces of marine loading arms in 2009, Kanon is keeping up their solid reputation of timely supply and engineering skills for custom-tailored design.

For example, a project of 7 marine loading arms with ultra-long reach of 35 meters has just been completed at the Vitol Terminal in Port Canaveral, Florida and a number of 20-inch marine loading arms for the Vopak terminal at Freetown, Bahama's have met a short delivery time and are planned to be complete in Q1-2010.

Currently, among others, Kanon is in the process of installing a 27-serie marine loading arms at the new Seatank Terminal in Antwerp, Belgium and 32 marine loading arms at the Port of Fujairah, UAE, both planned to be completed in Q2-2010.
